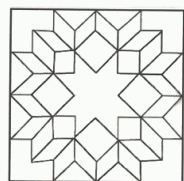

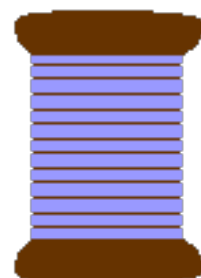

QUILT DROP OFF:

Quilt drop off does not have to be done by quilt owner. You may have someone else deliver them for you. Quilt drop off is the day of set up, Sept 17, 2015 from 12:00 noon to 3:00 pm at The Summit which is located at 9410 Davis Hwy, Dimondale. If you cannot bring them to the show site the day of set up and are unable to have someone else deliver your quilts you can call Jean Kaufmann at 517-347- 7555 or John Putnam at 517-505-3782 and make arrangements drop off BEFORE September 16, 2015.

YOU MUST HAVE A SLEEVE SECURELY ATTACHED!

There is a great video on You Tube. <https://youtu.be/bF81VRK4ilw> . You can also go to You Tube and do a search for “adding a sleeve to your quilt”.

Quilts will not be hung without an appropriate and securely attached sleeve. Acceptable size is at least 3 inches wide.

LABELING:

Stitch, or baste, a fabric label on the bottom of the back of your quilt. This label should include your name and the quilt title. You may include any other information that you wish.

Pickup will begin 1 hour after the quilt show closes. That is 6:00 pm on Saturday, September 19, 2015.

Bereavement Quilts	Children's quilts 24x24" with a plain light neutral backing fabric of 100% cotton. These quilts are given to the Emergency Room at Sparrow Hospital. Chemo Lap Quilts	Lap quilts given to chemo patients to help them stay warm during chemo treatments. At least 48x60" and no larger than 60x72".
