Quilt Drop Off and Preparation Instructions for Quilts Registered for the Guild 2017 Quilt Show

Attaching a Hanging Sleeve: Please see instructions on the vice-president's table for specific instructions on preparing a hanging sleeve. There is also a great video on You Tube. WWW.youtube.com/watch?v=bF81VRK4ilw&feature=youtube

You can also go to YouTube and do a search for Bonnie Browning adding a sleeve to your quilt. Bonnie forgot to mention that the fabric is cut 8 1/2 inches wide.

ALL quilts MUST have a sleeve with a minimum opening of 3 inches. Quilts will not be hung without an appropriate and securely attached sleeve.

Labeling: Stitch, or baste but do not pin, a fabric label on the bottom of the back of your quilt. This label should include your name and the quilt title. You may include any other information that you wish.

Packaging: DO NOT Place your quilts in a cloth bag. Please fold your quilts so that the owner's label is displayed. If you are dropping the quilts at Jean's home or John's home, then you must place your quilts in a cloth bag. Those bags, and only the early drop off bags, will be kept during the show and returned with the quilt.

Quilt Drop Off: Quilt drop off does not have be to done by quilt owner. You may have someone else deliver them for you. Quilt drop off is the day of setup - October 26, 2017 from 12:00 noon to 3:00 pm at The Summit, which is located at 9410 Davis Hwy., Dimondale. If you cannot bring them to the show site the day of setup and are unable to have someone else deliver your quilts, you can call Jean Kaufmann at 517-347-7555 or John Putnam 517-505-3782 and make arrangements to drop off ON OR BEFORE October 21, 2017.
