As a tribute and thank you to each CCQG Board President, Guild members are asked to make an Ohio Star block in the president's choice of colors. For the 2019 - 2020 President's block, John Putnam has asked that the blocks be black and cheddar Civil War repro fabrics. Colors can be in any position (cheddar star on black background or black star on cheddar background). The block size should be 11" unfinished, 10 1/2" finished.

Instructions


Cut from your background fabric (white below):

- 4 4" squares
- 2 4³/₄" squares. Cut these squares twice diagonally to make 8 quarter square triangles

Cut from your focus fabric (green/dark below):

- 1-4" square
- 2 4³/₄" squares. Cut these squares twice diagonally to make 8 quarter square triangles

The current Covid19 Shelter-in-Place has created some difficulties in transferring from our former treasurer, Dan Burke, to me as the new treasurer. So the following information is not in the usual format. The next 30 days should get everything in one place and the information will be current.

Our current cash balance is \$21,390.61. Most of the available cash is being held in reserve for the quilt show that is scheduled for next year, but there certainly is money available to keep doing what needs to be done. Rent at the church has been suspended until meetings are resumed. This amount includes some checks received but not yet deposited. The renewals of membership have been lower than normal as many are waiting to see if and when the Guild will return to active meetings.
